SUPPLIES

What You'll Need

Basic Supplies

- Cardstock
- Patterned paper
 - Adhesive
- Scissors or trimmer

Optional (but fun)

- Stamp set + ink
- Ribbon or twine
- Embellishments

Use what you already have and don't overthink it.

Simple is always a good place to start.

CARD #1

Simple Layered Hello



Supplies

1. Cardbase: 5 ½ X 48 1/2,, score 4 1/4
2. Card base: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", scored at 4 1/4"
3. Patterned paper: 4" x 5 1/4"
4. White cardstock: 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"
5. Ribbon or twine (optional)

Steps:

1. Fold your card base in half at the score line.
2. Adhere the patterned paper to the front of the card.
3. Stamp your greeting on the white cardstock piece.
4. Wrap ribbon or twine around the card front if desired.
5. Attach the sentiment piece to the center using adhesive or dimensionals.
6. Add embellishments if you'd like a little extra sparkle.



Keep the pattern paper busy and the sentiment simple. That balance makes the card look polished without extra work.

CARD 2

Quick Strip Card

Perfect for using scraps and creating something that looks thoughtfully designed.



Supplies:

1. Card base: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", scored at 4 1/4"
2. 3 strips patterned paper: 1" x 4"
3. White cardstock for sentiment

Steps:

1. Fold your card base in half.
2. Arrange three strips vertically on the card front.
3. Leave a small space between each strip for a clean look.
4. Adhere the strips once you like the layout.
5. Stamp your sentiment on white cardstock.
6. Trim into a rectangle or banner shape.
7. Attach the sentiment slightly below center.
8. Add ribbon or embellishments if desired.



Choose papers from the same pack. The card will look beautifully put together before you even add the greeting.

Framed Focal Card

This design adds a little layering for an elegant, finished look.

Supplies:

- Card base: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", scored at 4 1/4"
- Layer 1: 4" x 5 1/4" cardstock
- Layer 2: 3 3/4" x 5" patterned paper
- Focal piece: 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"



Steps:

1. Fold your card base in half.
2. Adhere Layer 1 to the card front.
3. Add patterned paper on top, centered evenly.
4. Stamp your image or sentiment on the focal piece.
5. Attach the focal piece to the mat layer.
6. Adhere to the center of the card using dimensionals.
7. Add ribbon or embellishments if desired.



Use a neutral card base and let the pattern paper shine.
It's the easiest way to create an elegant card.

SIMPLE GREETINGS

Simple Greetings That Always Work

Keep your messages short and versatile so you can use these cards anytime.

Try:

- Hello
- Thinking of You
- Happy Birthday
- Thank You
- Just a Note
- Sending a Smile
